

- Spent about \$550 on classroom aids from abilityhive.ca (aids help alleviate anxiety, hyperactivity, and boredom); Sara can say about how the aids were distributed; asked for feedback from teachers. My hope is that this will be helpful and we can dedicate future fundraising efforts for more.
- In talks with COC and POC re having one Olympian and one Paralympian visit the school as part of Eagles Unite. Cost is honorarium of \$200 total.
- Heard back from Roots of Empathy - they will put us on their list for next year
- Looking into Pawsitively Pets and classroom visits they do around Mental Health for students. I consider this DEI as students from some socioeconomic classes probably have little support in terms of mental health, but there's clear benefits for everyone. Without additional funds, this would be for future years.
- Spoke with Joze just now. He's willing to do an assembly for \$500 plus 5 referrals, which is a steal. He's willing to do evening event for parents for \$1000 — if we can get that grant that I can't remember the name of — this will go entirely to screening costs. Need permission from Sara, timing, details I'm not thinking of? I've also attached a screenshot of the different options Joze offers.
- Remaining funds I still plan to spend on posters, classroom books, and/or CBSN visit.
